In just a few short years, in 2022, the Diocese of Providence will celebrate a truly historic milestone – the 150th Anniversary of its founding. It is my intention to observe this great occasion with a variety of charitable, educational, and liturgical events.

In 2022, the Diocese of Providence will be celebrating the 150th anniversary of its founding in 1872. Since it was established, the Roman Catholic Diocese of Providence has grown exponentially and has served millions of Catholics. Comprised of the State of Rhode Island, the diocese encompasses 136 parishes, over 1,085 square miles, serving approximately 190,000 Catholic households. Additionally, the Diocese of Providence has a number of diocesan, parish and regional high schools and elementary schools that serve our population. In addition to these institutions, the diocese is home to adult care facilities, homes for the aged, youth camps and community centers, a number of monasteries and residences of priests and religious brothers and sisters.

In appreciation and gratitude for the nearly 150 years of the Diocese of Providence, Bishop Tobin has aptly themed our capital campaign *Grateful for God's Providence*. This historic effort has a goal of raising \$50,000,000 to help strengthen our parishes, encourage our vocations to the priesthood by supporting our seminarians, providing for retired priests, supporting our ability to care for the "least of God's people," and continue to maintain and support our Mother Church, the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul.















FORTY PERCENT OF ALL FUNDS GENERATED IN THE *GRATEFUL FOR GOD'S PROVIDENCE* CAMPAIGN WILL DIRECTLY AND POSITIVELY IMPACT
LOCAL PARISHES THROUGHOUT OUR DIOCESE. EACH PARISH WILL BE
ASSIGNED A "GOOD-FAITH TARGET." THESE TARGETS ARE "GOALS" NOT
"ASSESSMENTS," MEANING EACH PARISH COMMUNITY IS ASKED TO
SIMPLY DO THEIR BEST IN RAISING THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FUNDS.





















Forty percent of all funds collected up to the assigned target will be returned to the parishes for their local needs.

Once a parish surpasses its target,
60% of the funds raised above that point will be returned to the parish.

The Diocese of Providence will collect donor contributions and disburse funds to the parishes on a quarterly basis for their own needs.

Some examples of how parishes may use the proceeds from the *Grateful for God's Providence* campaign include:

- Making necessary repairs to the parish plant.
- Expanding or renovating church facilities.
- Paying off historic or current debts.
- Establishing a maintenance fund for future repairs or projects.
- Creating a new parish ministry or strengthening existing ministries.

Through the parish-sharing component, the *Grateful for God's Providence* campaign hopes to realize a minimum of \$20,000,000.





THE DIOCESE OF PROVIDENCE IS COMMITTED TO PROVIDING FOR THE PASTORAL AND SACRAMENTAL NEEDS OF OUR PARISH COMMUNITIES BY PROVIDING FOR THE FORMATION OF MEN FOR THE PRIESTHOOD.









Seminarian formation is a six-to-eightyear process beginning in college and continuing with theological studies in major seminary. The cost of a major seminary education and formation has risen steadily to approximately \$56,500 a year per seminarian. The collective cost to the Diocese of Providence is approaching \$685,000 annually.

A financial analysis of the past five years indicates that the costs associated with forming and educating the future priests of the Diocese of Providence has incurred an annual operational deficit of approximately \$500,000. This deficit has been funded primarily by the Diocesan General Fund, Catholic Charity Appeal and by drawing on the seminarian

education endowment fund. If nothing is done and due to other diocesan financial constraints, it will be impossible to continue to fund these deficits in the years ahead.

Funds generated from the *Grateful for God's Providence* campaign will primarily add to the existing endowment that exists to help seminarians enrolled in the advanced study of theology. Additionally, some of the generated funding will go to assist Our Lady of Providence Seminary and its mission. This campaign hopes to add \$8,000,000 to the current Most Reverend Robert E. Mulvee Fund for the Education of Seminarians to help meet the costs of forming and educating our current and future seminarians.







THE DIOCESE OF PROVIDENCE IS BLESSED TO HAVE APPROXIMATELY 100
PRIESTS WHO HAVE EACH LOVINGLY SERVED AND HAVE NOW RETIRED
FROM ACTIVE MINISTRY. OFTEN RETIRING BETWEEN THE AGES 70-75,
MANY MEN WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE PART-TIME, BY ASSISTING
IN PARISHES ON A REGULAR BASIS, WHILE OTHERS REQUIRE
ASSISTED LIVING OR NURSING HOME CARE.

Between 2017 and 2025, there will be approximately 50 priests, now in active ministry, who will be eligible for retirement. Due to the increasing number of retired priests, the shortfall of the retirement fund has increased to \$800,000 annually. These shortfalls have been subsidized through the Diocesan General Fund and Annual Catholic Charity Appeal. In order to finance the operations of both the priest retirement and medical programs, we must expand the current Our Lady, Queen of Clergy Retirement Fund Endowment by approximately \$8,000,000. The financial support will help address the retirement benefits and medical expenses of the current retired priests as well as the increasing number of retired priests into the foreseeable future.

FOR OVER 165 YEARS, CATHOLIC SCHOOLS IN THE DIOCESE OF PROVIDENCE HAVE PARTNERED WITH PARENTS AND GUARDIANS TO EDUCATE CHILDREN. TODAY'S SCHOOLS FOLLOW A RIGOROUS STANDARDS AND FAITH-BASED CURRICULUM THAT ADDRESSES THE SPIRITUAL, ACADEMIC, ARTISTIC, SOCIAL AND PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF OUR STUDENTS.

Nurturing a well-educated community that embodies the Gospel values of Christ is key to ensuring the future of our church. Each year, more families apply for financial assistance so their children may attend a Catholic school.

Our current financial assistance falls well below the calculated need; in fact, we are only able to help 10% of the families that apply for assistance. In this campaign, we are raising a minimum of \$5,000,000 for Catholic

education tuition assistance. This will add to the current Anchor of Hope 21st Century Endowment Fund, assisting families and their students with tuition aid, based on demonstrated financial need.

We must ensure that we have schools that are available, accessible and affordable to every Catholic school student and parent who desires a Catholic education for their children regardless of their financial means.

Annually, our Social Services provides:

- Support to families facing unplanned pregnancies and their newborn children up to age four.
- Counseling and healing to women who have experienced an abortion.
- Support and healing to those afflicted by alcohol or drug addiction.
- Assistance to over 8,000 individuals who may be seeking safety for themselves and their families from their war-torn native countries.
- Training in English as a second language helping individuals to become more marketable in the workforce.
- Safe housing and aid to refugees and immigrants in need, as well as services to aid them in finding dignified employment.
- Care for our senior citizens through providing Elder Services and respite breaks for their caregivers especially those caring for elderly/disabled family members.
- Friendly visitors for the isolated and homebound.

The Grateful for God's Providence campaign will earmark approximately \$4,000,000 towards preservation and maintenance of our beautiful Cathedral, as well as expanding the current Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul Endowment Fund to address future needs.

PLEDGES VIA CASH, CHECK OR CREDIT/DEBIT CARD

Simply complete your pledge card and select the timeframe of your payments. If you choose to make a down payment via check, please make it payable to *Grateful for God's Providence*. We are currently accepting Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.

Once completed, please return your pledge card by mail in the provided return envelope. The Development Office will send payment reminder statements and a special payment envelope in accordance with the payment plan you have chosen. For those choosing the automatic payment option via credit or debit card, you will not receive reminder statements.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

Donors may use stock and or mutual funds to pay their pledge. If the stock has been held long-term (over one year), the donor does not have to pay capital gains tax on the stock, and is allowed a tax deduction for the average value of the stock on the date received. Donors may also choose to sell stock in order to claim a loss, which may be beneficial for tax circumstances. In either case, the stock must first be transferred to the Diocese before being liquidated.
