Our campaign director for our small parish community was Jon Van Beaver. First of all, on behalf of our parish community, I offer thanks for Jon's leadership and guidance throughout the campaign process. He was always available and willing to go the extra mile in order that our campaign was as successful as possible – supplying all the necessary materials, providing continuous campaign updates, attending the various meetings, and being present at our receptions.
